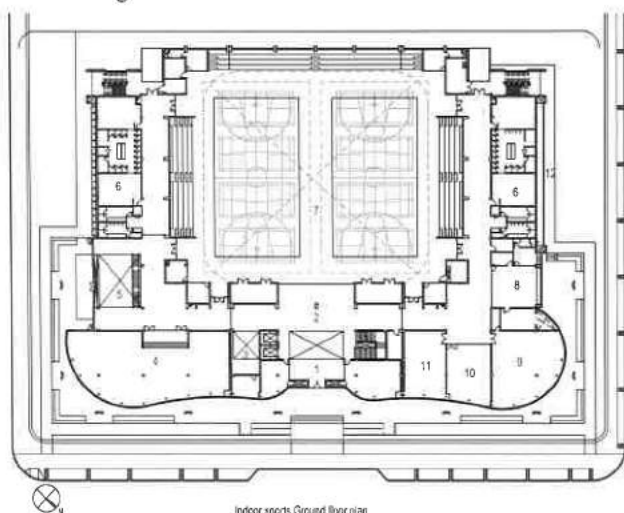
The design of the 1,15,000 sq ft indoor sports complex at Shiv Nadar University, Greater Noida was led by the vision of creating a versatile sporting facility comparable to international standards. The essence of the design lies in the balance it achieves between structure and interior space brought by vivacious use of colours and bold graphics juxtaposed with the pronounced muscular form of the building.

The exposed RCC and arterial elements in the structure draw analogy with an active body frame. A curvilinear canopy supported by steel columns and lightweight transparent glazing add flare to the expansive structure. The glass façade provides a visual connect between the inside and the outside. A multi-functional sports hall forms the core of the building. The bold use of graphics and motivational phrases in the interior spaces enhance the inspirational spirit of the building. A screen made in steel with a sports-theme, in the front façade stands out, giving the building an ultra-modern look. The design specifications strictly follow international standards to create a world-class sporting experience to its users. The stadium accommodates a range of contemporary sports. An engaging cafeteria and other open spaces facilitate socializing, making this building 'one-for-all'.
